O you who believe! Obey Allah, and obey the Messenger, and those charged with authority among you.

If you differ in anything among yourselves, refer it to Allah and His Messenger, if you do believe in Allah and the Last Day:

That is best, and most suitable for final determination.

(Al Quran Chapter 4 Verses 59)

The above verse of Quran is telling you that

Allah(swt) has commanded you to obey your rulers, your officers in job, and other people having authorities over matters concerning you but at the same time be careful because if any of them would give you some order to do indecent act or crime or something not liked by Allah(swt) then you must not obey

Remember your ruler or your employer has not given you life nor he is keeping you alive, whatever you are given is from Allah(swt) so you must care for the commands of Allah(swt) only and must not be afraid while obeying HIM
